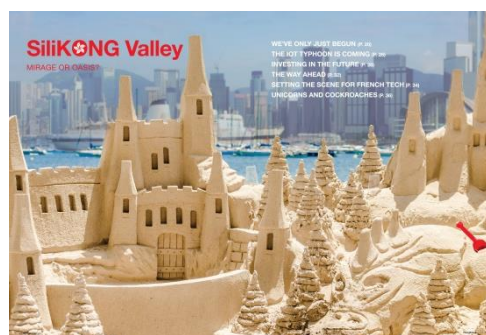
Editorial Committee
